<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Awkward body position whilst undertaking this activity.• Electric shock from voltage on cables and equipment.• Danger of camera and ancillary equipment becoming detached from its mounted position.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Follow safe manual handling procedures.• Confirm EAW safety testing of cables and equipment.• Visual check of cables and equipment prior to handling.• Ensure that cables and equipment are rigged in such a way that they cannot be damaged by scenery or other equipment, or trapped in moving parts and not to cause any obstruction.• Keep cables and equipment clear of heat from luminaires, and water.• Safety bond camera and ancillary equipment if it is mounted such that it could cause damage or injury should it become loose.
